

MEASURING FOR CORRECT SIZE

These are basic guidelines and there may be some exceptions.

COAT

(chest measurement determines coat size)

- CHEST** - to get a proper chest measurement you should bring the tape measure around the fullest part of the chest. The tape should be kept under the arms and across the shoulder blades. To get the coat size you add two inches to this measurement.
- LENGTH** - (sleeve length determines coat length.) the length of the coat is determined by the shirt sleeve. See the chart below when ordering coat length

| Coat size | Sleeve Length | Coat Length |
|-----------|-------------------|-------------|
| 34-39 | 32" or less | Short |
| | 33" - 33 1/2" | Reg |
| | 34" - 35" | Long |
| | 35 1/2" or longer | X-Long |
| 40-44 | 32" or less | Short |
| | 33" - 34 1/2" | Reg |
| | 35" - 35 1/2" | Long |
| | 36" or longer | X-Long |
| 46-52 | 33" or less | Short |
| | 34" - 34 1/2" | Reg |
| | 35" - 36" | Long |
| | 36 1/2" or longer | X-Long |
| 54-64 | 33" or less | Short |
| | 34" - 35" | Reg |
| | 36" | Long |
| | 37" or longer | X-Long |

EXAMPLE: your chest size measurement is 41" and your sleeve is 34". A 43 reg. coat should be



TROUSERS

- WAIST** - When measuring the waist you should always measure around the shirt and never around the pants or coat. Measure just above the hip bones and across the naval. By Keeping two fingers between your body and the tape measure you will insure a comfortable fit.

LENGTH - at Baryames we are able to use either your inseam or outseam for pant length. You may use whichever you prefer.

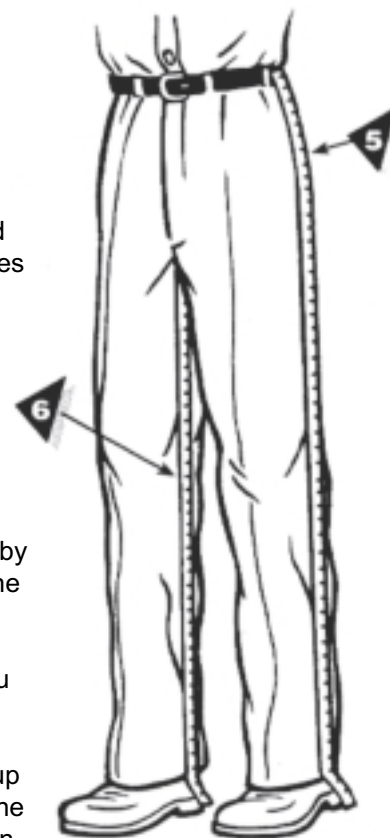
- OUTSEAM** - an outseam measurement is obtained by beginning at the top of the waistline and bringing the tape down to where the pant should fall on your shoe; generally to the top of the heel. Before you begin measurement adjust your pants to where you would generally wear your pants on your waist.

- INSEAM** - to measure the inseam pull your pants up to where they are comfortable and measure from the pant crotch seam to where your pants should fall on the shoe. Generally to the top of the heel.

SHIRT

- NECK** - bring the tape measure around the base of the neck until the tape is snug. You should only be able to fit one finger between the tape measure and your neck. Write down exact measurements including half sizes.

- SLEEVE** - start your measurement from the very center of the collar at the base of the neck - carry the tape measure over the shoulder and down the length of the arm to one inch above the wrist bone.



MEASURING FOR BOYS SIZES

Taking a boys measurement is more difficult and should be done with extra attention. In general, boys are measured in the same way as men but additional information such as age, height, and weight are extremely helpful in determining what size a boy should wear. The chart to the right can help in determining what size is needed this is only a guideline and may not be accurate in all cases.
